PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

- Reconstruct existing roadway from 2 lanes to 4 lanes
- Construct designated bike lanes and sidewalks on both sides of the roadway
- Upgrade the lighting system
- Construct an 18-foot wide curbed median
- Improve existing drainage system
- Upgrade existing traffic signal concrete poles to steel mast arms

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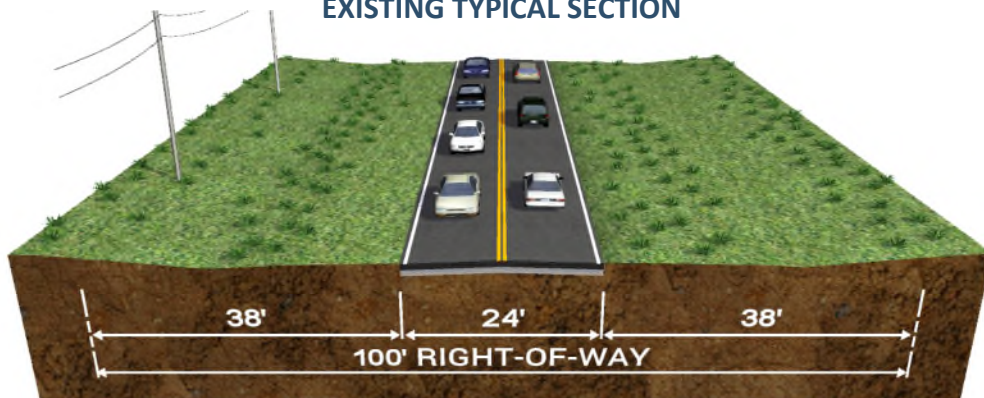
