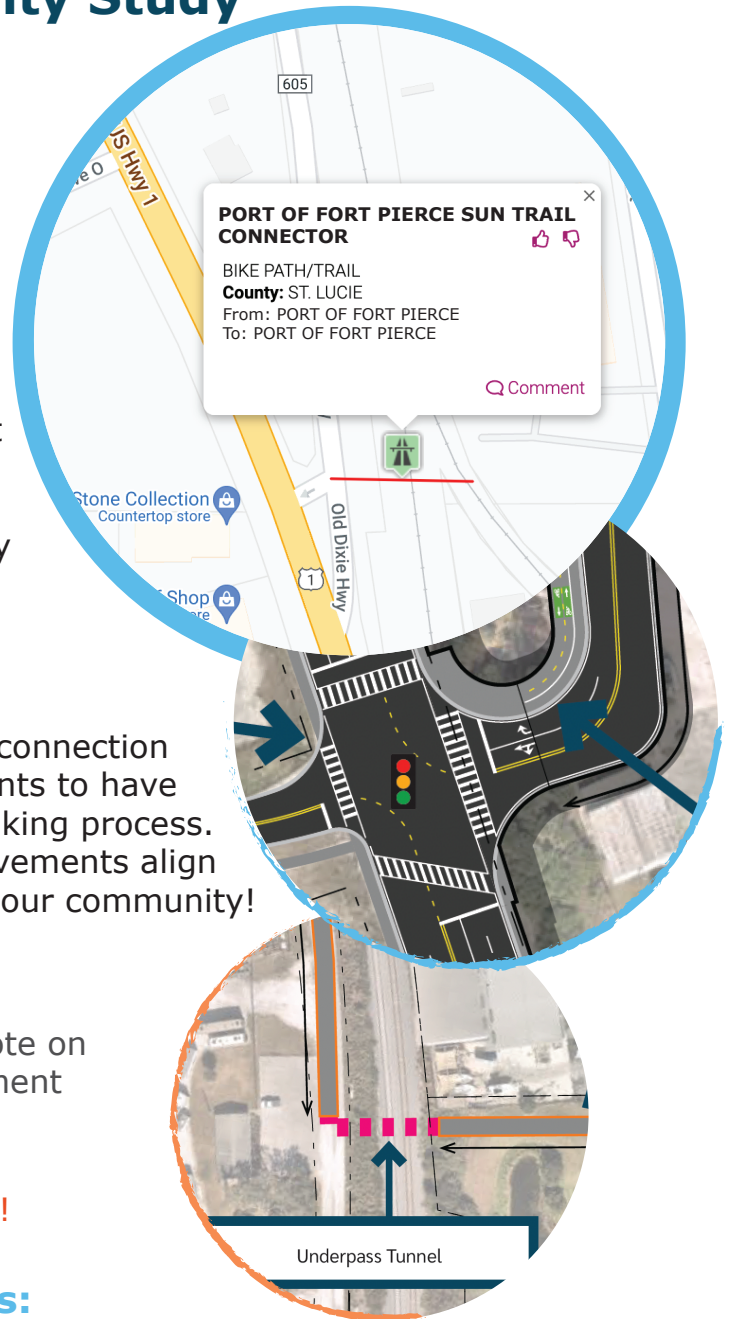


Florida Shared-Use Network (SUN) Trail Port of Fort Pierce Sun Trail Connector Feasibility Study
